

CONTACT TRACING TOOL

For People Being Tested for COVID-19



Students, teachers, and faculty being tested for COVID-19 should take steps to identify individuals he or she may have had contact with. This form can help to identify close contacts and be ready to relate this information to the appropriate officials. Parents are encouraged to promptly complete this worksheet with their children to capture recall of past events as accurately as possible. If a positive PCR or antigen test result is received, please call Louisiana Department of Health Contact Tracing Team at **(877) 766-2130** once this worksheet is complete.

This worksheet will prepare you for some of the questions public health officials will need to determine appropriate next steps and act. You may also reach out to your school administrator with this information, and ask about their plans for responding to COVID-19 outbreaks at the school, including contact-tracing activities and other resource support.
