 - **To and from school ONLY**
- Infractions result in progressive consequences:
 - Cadet counselling
 - Parents called, cadets sent to ISS until corrected
 - Extra Military Instruction after school
 - Saturday Detention
 - Suspension

The Marine Corps Uniform Board released 36 new regulations Aug. 1, many governing the banned styles:

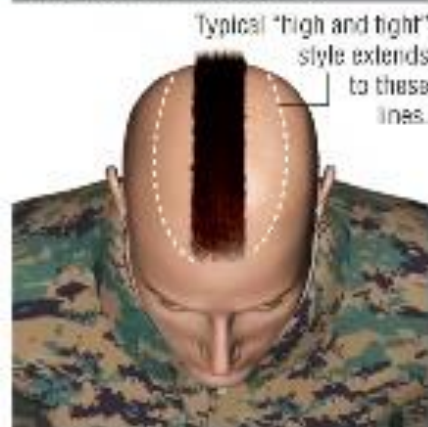

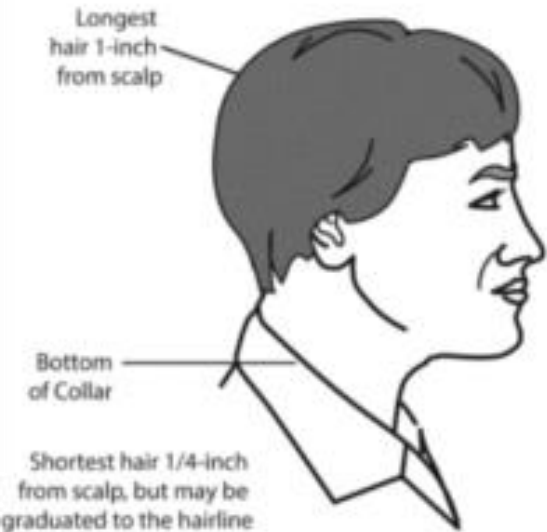

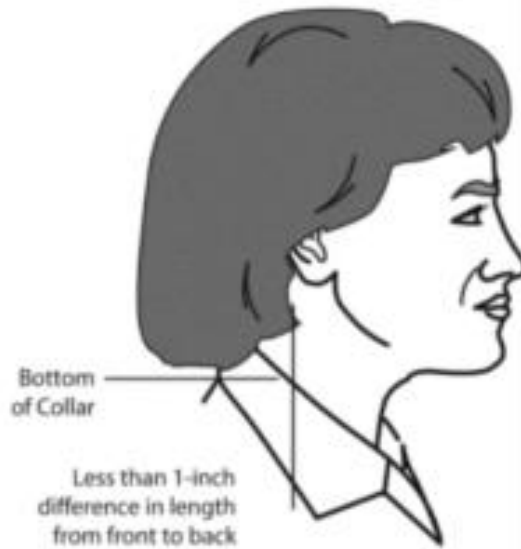

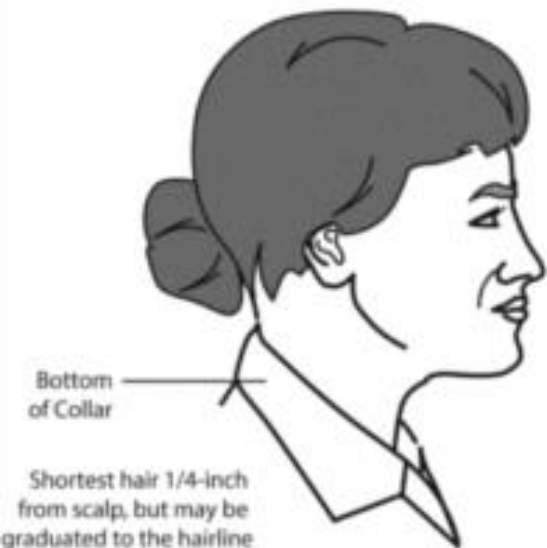
Short Hair Length



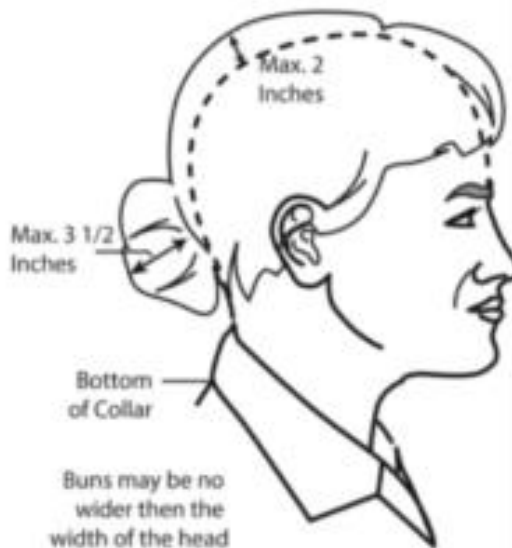
Medium Hair Length



Long Hair Length



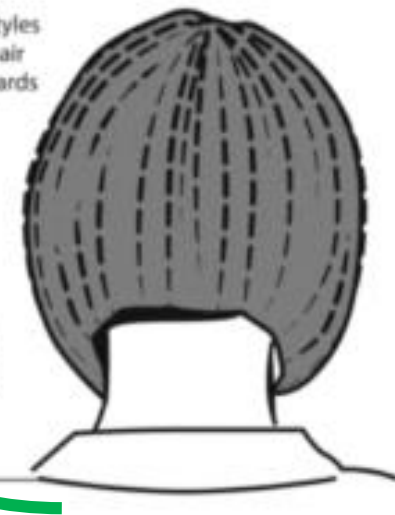
Bulk of Hair



Braids of fashionable styles must conform to all hair and appearance standards

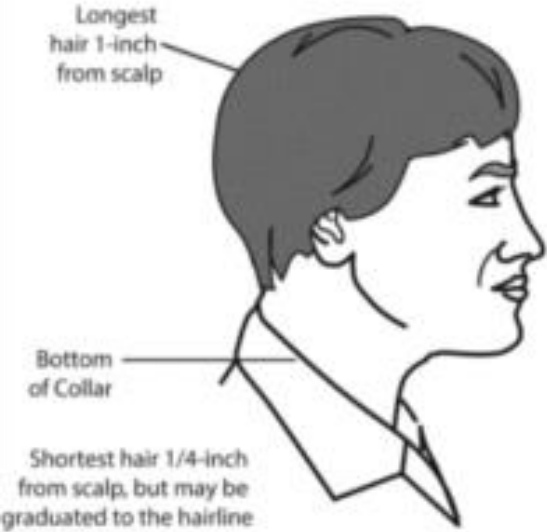
Less than 1-inch difference in length from front to back

Bottom of Collar

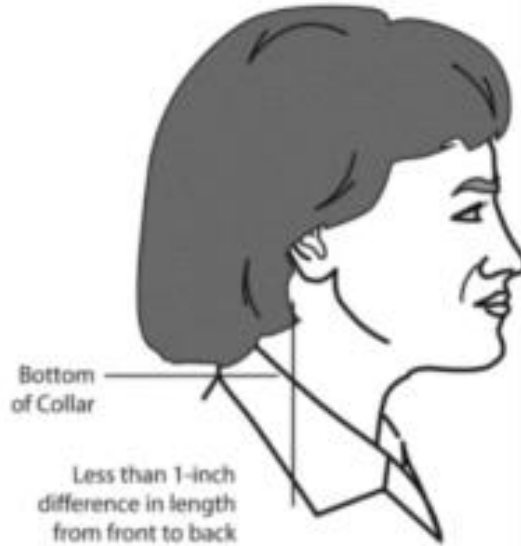

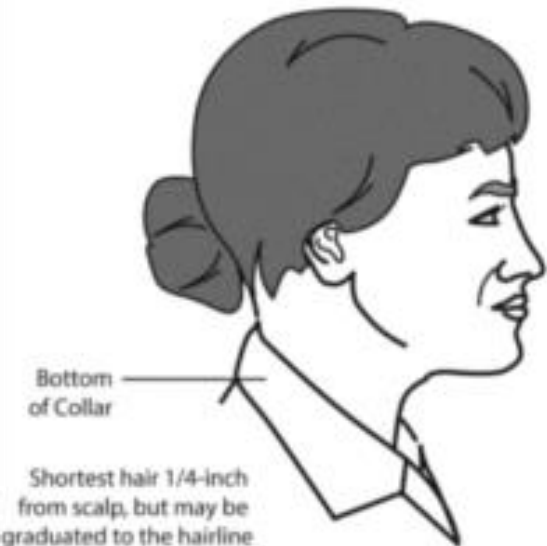

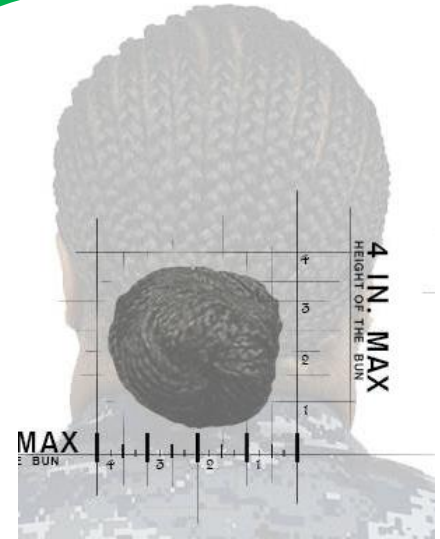
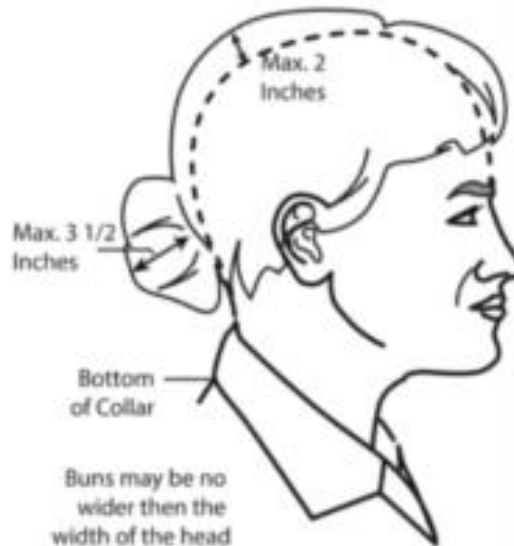

Headband is not plain



Twists are not authorized

Loose, unsecured hair

Unauthorized Hairstyles



❑ Hair not properly secured



❑ Unbalanced or lopsided hairstyle



❑ Part is not one straight line

Unauthorized Female Hairstyles



More than 1" difference in length from front



Bangs fall below eyebrows



Scrunchie color is not similar to hair color
