1. Situation. The purpose of this LOI is to announce the Annual NOMMA Marine Corps JROTC Drill Competition. The MCJROTC Region 5 Drill Competitions were created to showcase the top MCJROTC units in Region 5. This Letter of Instruction (LOI) provides information, conduct, rules and tasking for the 3rd Annual NOMMA MCJROTC Drill Competition in accordance with the references.

2. Mission. At 0800, Sat 2 December 2023 NOMMA will host the 6th Annual Drill Competition at the Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base (NAS JRB) New Orleans.

3. Execution

a. Commanders Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent

(a) My intent is to host the Drill Competition (Armed, Unarmed, and Color Guard) to provide an opportunity for the cadets to showcase their drill abilities. This competition will be conducted with integrity, teamwork, motivation and safety at all times. All schools are welcome and will be required to pay their own way to compete at this event, or abide by the 10 week window in accordance with PSB policy; i.e. travel, entry fee, meals, and lodging/hotel as required. All PRDs must be received NLT 29 September 2023. Schools must compete in every category, except Knockout Drill, to be considered for overall meet champion.

(2) Concept of Operations

(a) This competition will be conducted over five phases.

(1) Phase I Registration. Registration ends on close of business **24 November 2023**.

(2) Phase II Travel & Check-in. This phase (Fri/Sat 1/2 Dec) schools will need to arrive at Bldg 492 (Naval Operations Support Center, NOSC) between 0600-0730. A check-in table at the Bldg entrance will have your changing room assignments as well as your event time schedule.

(4) **Phase IV Competition.** This phase begins at 0800, 2 December and will end at approximately 1400. Teams will check-in at the individual competition locations (see Encl (1)) NLT 10 minutes prior. Judges will use a paper-scoring system with runners to the command and control center.

(5) **Phase V Awards Ceremony.** This phase begins at approx 1330 on 2 Dec after all cadets are in the awards location. The sequence will consist of team awards and Meet Championship awards. This phase ends at approximately 1400. Awards will not be mailed and must be picked up.

(6) **Phase VI Travel.** This phase begins at the end of awards ceremony and is enroute to their home location.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) Region 5 SMI/MI:

(a) Submit Entry Form NLT COB **24 November 2023.**

(b) Comply with all rules for competition contained within LOI.

(c) Ensure cadets do NOT eat or drink in changing rooms

(2) Entry fee for all MCJROTC schools will be \$300. Make checks payable to **NOMMA.**

c. Coordinating Instructions. Specific instructions and information is located on the Drill Google Site. You MUST be logged into your MCJROTC.ORG account then go to [MCJROTC \(nomma.net\)](http://MCJROTC(nomma.net)) to view category rules, scoring, event layout, timeline, entry form, award categories, drill cards and all other pertinent information.
