

NEW ORLEANS MILITARY AND MARITIME ACADEMY FEE POLICY

It is the policy of New Orleans Military and Maritime Academy that fees charged to students shall not prevent economically disadvantaged students from having access to a quality education. Furthermore, student failure to pay a fee shall not be denied or delayed admission nor denied access to any instructional activity. Report cards and other academic records cannot be withheld for failure to pay a fee, pursuant to state law ([R.S. 17:112\(C\)](#)).

Fees charged:

Parking fee - \$10

Locker fee - \$5

Laptop rental fee (only juniors and seniors eligible to rent a laptop; laptop rental by parent request only and is not required) - \$50

Further description of fees can be found in NOMMA Parent/Cadet Handbook. All fees collected will support technology resources at NOMMA.

Fees are collected throughout the year by NOMMA Office Staff and can be paid by cash, check or money order.

Parents or students may request a fee waiver by contacting the Business Manager or student's counselor. Waiver of fees is provided for students whose families are experiencing economic hardships and are financially unable to pay them. Examples of families facing economic hardship include, but are not necessarily limited to, families receiving unemployment benefits or public assistance, including Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Medicaid; foster families caring for children in foster care; and families that are homeless.
