Included in this mailing is the interim report card for the second nine week grading period. There are three weeks remaining in this semester. The semester grade is comprised 40% from the first nine weeks grade, 40% from the second nine weeks grade and 20% from the semester exam. Please review the interim report card. If you have questions about your cadet's grades, please contact the teacher of record for the course (all staff email addresses are listed on nomma.net) or contact your cadet's counselor to set a parent/teacher conference. Mrs. Mathews is the counselor for grades 9 and 10 (tmathews@nomma.net) and Dr. Krentel is the counselor for grades 11 and 12 (dkrentel@nomma.net).

As a reminder NOMMA courses are full year courses. NOMMA does not issue course credit until the end of the school year and the course has been completed. Course credit is determined by averaging the Quality Points from first semester with the Quality Points from second semester. Grades are assigned Quality Points ranging from 4-0 for grades A-F. To earn a Carnegie unit in a full-unit course, a cadet must earn a minimum of one quality point as a final grade **and** must pass Semester 2.
