Included in this mailing is the interim report card for the second nine week grading period. Also included is a demographic sheet for your cadet. Please review and send back to the school office with corrections if there is any incorrect information. We appreciate your assistance in ensuring we have correct information regarding your address, phone number and email address.

There are three weeks remaining in this semester. The semester grade is comprised 40% from the first nine weeks grade, 40% from the second nine weeks grade and 20% from the semester exam. Please review the interim report card. If you have questions about your cadet's grades, please contact the teacher of record for the course (all staff email addresses are listed on [nomma.net](http://nomma.net)) or contact your cadet's counselor to set a parent/teacher conference. Mrs. Mathews is the counselor for grade 9 ([tmathews@nomma.net](mailto:tmathews@nomma.net)), Mrs. Jorge for grades 10 and 11 ([sjorge@nomma.net](mailto:sjorge@nomma.net)) and Mr. Clayton is the counselor for grade 12 ([mclayton@nomma.net](mailto:mclayton@nomma.net)).

As a reminder NOMMA courses are full year courses. NOMMA does not issue course credit until the end of the school year and the course has been completed. Course credit is determined by averaging the Quality Points from first semester with the Quality Points from second semester. Grades are assigned Quality Points ranging from 4-0 for grades A-F. To earn a Carnegie unit in a full-unit course, a cadet must earn a minimum of one quality point as a final grade **and** must pass Semester 2. Please encourage your cadet to prepare for mid-term exams and to finish the semester on a positive note.
