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Dear Parents,

Congratulations to our graduating Class of 2016. Special Congratulations to our Valedictorian Alexys Wright and Salutatorian Tyler McNabb. We look forward to hearing about the success of our 2016 graduates in years to come.

Cadets who did not clean out their lockers must do so by June 3. Items found in lockers that have not been cleaned out by this date will be donated to Goodwill.

Several documents are included within this mailing: final report card, class detail report, ACT Plan scores, summer reading projects and summer school registration. Cadets are expected to complete the summer reading project and will receive a grade in their English class based on the summer project

As you review report cards, you will see stickers are included indicating if your cadet was promoted or retained. If your child has an F# listed as the final grade for the course, as per local policies included in the NOMMA Parent/Cadet handbook, one of the following reasons was the basis for the F#:

1. Cadets must pass second semester;
2. If a failing grade was earned first semester, the second semester grade of C must be earned to receive credit;
3. A cadet may not miss more than 14 days of school per Louisiana Department of Education policy. Seat time recovery was available for missing between 15-19 days. Otherwise a cadet must pass the course **and** pass the final exam to earn credit if more than 14 days were missed. Excused and unexcused absences are included in the count of 14 days.

Several weeks ago information regarding summer school classes was mailed home. There are two sessions this summer, each 4 weeks (May 31- 24 and June 27 - July 22). The deadline for registering for Session One is June 2 and the deadline for registering for Session Two is June 29. Summer school courses will be offered online. Cadets will only be allowed to take **one** class per session. The cost for each class is \$200. Cadets may take summer school courses in core content area for credit recovery, if needed, or may take an extra course to get ahead in their graduation program or prepare for Advanced Placement courses. Courses with an End of Course Exam are only offered for credit recovery. Payment for summer school is due by the first day of the summer session.

Cadets have the option of coming to school to work on these courses from 8-12 each day or work from home. **Final Exams for online courses must be taken on campus with the teacher proctor. No credit will be given unless a passing grade is earned on the Final Exam.**

Laptops will **not** be issued during the summer. Breakfast, lunch and transportation will **not** be provided during the summer classes. If you have questions about summer school, please contact your cadet's counselor for more information.

Summer JROTC camps are listed below. If you are interested in attending a camp and have not yet signed up for a camp, please contact your JROTC instructor. Summer JROTC camps run from 0700 – 1130 during the week of the camp.
