Dear Parents,

We have had a very successful opening for the 2015/16 school year and appreciate your support.

Please remember to return all annual school registration documents and the lunch application if you are interested in receiving free or reduced lunch. The price of breakfast is \$1.70 and lunch \$2.85.

Included in this mailing is a Home Language Survey translated for families' who do not read English. Once this is returned we will be able to translate other documents to better communicate with all of our parents.

A revised posting of bus stops for non-Orleans cadets has been posted on the school's website.

Please remember that NOMMA has a very specific grooming and dress code policy to comply with cadets wearing of the Marine Corps uniform. You have chosen to have your child attend NOMMA and therefore you choose to comply with these standards as a condition of enrollment. These policies are not negotiable. The Cadet Guidebook describes appropriate haircut requirements and pages 21-22 describe appropriate khaki uniform requirements for the civilian uniform.

Our non-military, or civilian uniform is available for purchase from our uniform vendor Poree's at 3630 MacArthur Blvd. Suite C-B New Orleans, LA 70114. The civilian uniform consists of a **white shirt (long or short sleeved) with the NOMMA emblem, a red tie for the male cadets and red tab tie for the female cadets, black shoes (any style), black belt, belted khaki pants and black socks. The black shoes must be completely black, no other colors on the shoe (including the sole) and black laces.** Female cadets may wear a khaki skirt. The skirt must be knee length and worn with a belt if appropriate. NOMMA sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets are available for purchase. Cadets are not allowed to wear any other garments except the NOMMA uniform. This means no hoodies, jackets, or over shirts will be allowed, only NOMMA authorized uniform apparel. Shorts are not a uniform option. Cadets are also not allowed to wear jackets inside the school building (except the School Letterman's Jacket). If your child is cold natured, you may want to consider a purchase of the NOMMA sweatshirt or sweater.
