- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for 30 seconds; don't just do a short rinse.
- Cover any coughs or sneezes with your elbow. Do not use your hands!
- Be conscious of how often you touch your face and try to minimize that contact.
- Limit close personal body contact, including shaking hands. Use fist pump if appropriate.
- Help keep the school and your home clean. Clean surfaces frequently, such as countertops, light switches, TV remotes, cellphones and other frequently touched areas.
- Stay home if you are genuinely sick, until you are feeling better.

NOMMA administration is working with our custodial staff and cleaning company to keep the school as clean as possible, but we need your help to best ensure your safety, health, and welfare.
